Academic Year

The academic year at Palucca University is divided into two semesters (terms):

BA Dance Programme

Applications are only possible for an exchange beginning in the winter semester.

The language of instruction is English. Erasmus Incoming students are required to have an English level of minimum B1. [Further information](#)

Application process

After being selected by your home university, you are welcome to apply for acceptance at the Palucca University of Dance Dresden. The number of students that can be enrolled is limited and applicants will be assessed by their artistic aptitude.

Please hand in:

- Application form for exchange students
- Letter of motivation (in PDF format)
- A tabular resume (CV) with precise information regarding your previous education (in PDF format)
- One head shot photo (JPG format)
- Two to three dance photos (JPG format)
- Application videos as described on our website
- Transcript of records from your home university

Once the application is submitted with the required supporting documentation, the application is processed and a decision is made whether to offer a place of study to the applicant, or not. Successful applicants will receive a letter of acceptance for their place of study.

Learning Agreement, ECTS and Assessment

For arranging your Erasmus Learning Agreement, Palucca University will support you with information concerning the availability of courses as well as the number of ECTS points awarded to each course unit. The university applies the ECTS (European Credit Transfer System), which is based on the principle that 60 credits measure the workload of a full-time student during one academic year. This system facilitates the recognition of mobility achievements.

For completing your Erasmus learning agreement and for further arrangements during your Erasmus student exchange, you need to inform the Erasmus-Coordinator whether you will need to provide differentiated assessment (grades) or non-differentiated assessment (pass/fail) with your chosen courses.

Semester fee

Exchange studies within the Erasmus programme are free of tuition. However, every student has to pay a semester fee. The semester fee includes the ticket for the public transport system in Dresden.

Before you leave Palucca University

Please remember these important matters:

- Please get in touch with the Department of student affairs for the removal from the register of students
- please get in touch with the Erasmus-Coordinator concerning the issuance of your Transcript of Records
- Please collect all certificates and proof of course participation, so that you can present them at your home university
- Please check with your home university, if other documents, such as a confirmation of stay, are needed.

After your stay at Palucca University of Dance Dresden, a transcript of records will be provided to you by the department of student affairs.
