

## Public Call for Applications

### Awarding of a State Scholarship by the Free State of Saxony for Graduate Studies

In accordance with Section 2 Paragraph 1 of the Saxon State Scholarship Regulations (SächsLStipVO) of October 23, 2024, the Palucca University of Dance Dresden awards a state scholarship for students of the Artistic Master Class. Eligible for funding are artistic research and artistic development projects by students within the framework of an Artistic Master Class Programme the Palucca University of Dance Dresden.

The award of a Saxon State Scholarship for Graduates requires enrolment in an Artistic Master Class Programme at the Palucca University of Dance Dresden in accordance with Section 43 of the Saxon State Higher Education Act (SächsHG). Funding begins on August 1, 2025, and is limited to July 31, 2027, provided the corresponding funds are made available from the budget of the Free State of Saxony.

The recipient of a state scholarship receives a monthly amount of €1,500 (basic scholarship). In addition, a child allowance of €100 is granted for each child living in the recipient's household, not just temporarily. The basic scholarship and child allowance are awarded as project funding through fixed-amount funding.

The following documents must be attached to the application form in German or a translation:

- Proof of enrolment in the Artistic Master Class
- in the case of paid secondary employment please add an employment contract, stating the working hours per week (max. 8 hours)
- in the case of dependent children, a copy of the birth certificates and child benefit notices, as well as a declaration from the other parent, stating whether or not they receive a scholarship

**Only applications submitted by August 15, 2025, with complete documentation, will be considered.**

The Freiberg Student Union is the approval authority for state scholarships. The approval authority issues the funding notification to the recipient based on the available budget and the decisions of the respective university.

The university forwards the applications to the funding authority along with the respective basic decision. If more applications meet the academic requirements for funding than the number of state scholarships available to the university, the university can establish a priority order.

The funding authority issues the funding decision to the grant recipient based on the available budget and the decisions of the respective university.

**Declaration of Consent:**

Applicants consent to their data being processed (e.g., stored and evaluated) by the Palucca University of Dance Dresden for the purpose of selection and forwarded to the persons involved in the selection process (including funding bodies and approval authorities). The authorization for this is their consent in accordance with Art. 6 (1) GDPR on the application form. Applicants may revoke this consent in writing at any time with future effect and request the immediate deletion of their electronically stored data. However, participation in the application and scholarship process will no longer be possible once the data has been deleted. The personal data collected for the purpose of applying for the State Graduate Scholarship will be deleted after the application process has been completed. The scholarship holder's documents will be destroyed in accordance with data protection regulations five years after the expiration of the objection period.
