



**Rules of Conduct – Protection and Safety Rules  
Secondary School (Oberschule) and Palucca University of Dance Dresden  
as of August 23, 2021**

**1. Campus-access – general rules**

a) There are strict standards for Campus-access and staying on-Campus. Access to the Campus is only allowed for employees, students and people/guests who are crucial for maintaining operation of the university. **Access to the Campus via main entrance only (Basteiplatz 4) – after the respective classes, after having finished respective work/duties, everyone has to leave the Campus as soon as possible and directly by using the main entrance as a general rule.**

b) Everyone who enters the Campus is required to right away sanitize/disinfect or wash their hands thoroughly.

c) External people/guests who are not crucial for maintaining operation of the university and for ensuring academic teaching may only be admitted to the Campus by special invitation of the University and/or Secondary School. Groups of more than 2 people have to be reported to and granted access by the Palucca Crisis Management Team. The respective staff members/employees are responsible for sharing the Rules of Conduct – Protection and Safety Rules and for verifying the test result as well and they have to meet and pick up their guests at the reception / main entrance. All external people/guests have to hand in their data/contact information and the beginning and end dates of their stay at the reception/main entrance. All data is classified as confidential data and will be deleted after 21 days.

**2. Mandatory testing**

Admittance to Campus will only be granted to people who can verify that they are SARS-CoV-2-negative, the verifying qualified proof/ document (confirming the negative test result) must have been issued within the last three days.

**Any person who has been fully vaccinated and/or has recovered - as defined in the respective Corona Protection Ordinance - is exempt from mandatory testing (pls. see “3 G” rule).**

**3. Temporary special provisions -mandatory testing**

a) **As of starting the academic/school year, during the weeks 36. and 37 of 2021 (September 06-19, 2021) testing will be mandatory three times a week every two days.**

b) **Employees, who have been absent from the university and who have not been at work for at least consecutive five days (due to vacation, or due to any other comparable time-off or work exemption) have to present their employer a verifying qualified proof/ document (confirming the negative test result) issued the same day they start working, or they have to do a documented test under supervision during their first day at work. Starting work from home (home office), the respective rule has to be observed the first day when work will be resumed at the university or at any other place away from home.**

**Any person who has been fully vaccinated and has recovered - as defined in the respective Corona Protection Ordinance - is exempt from mandatory testing as defined in 3. a) and b) – pls. see also “3 G” rule.**

**4. Symptom-free status**

Access and admittance to the Campus **will not be granted** to any person

- who has been tested positive for SARS -CoV-2 infection/COVID-19-disease,
- who shows at least one symptom that is similar or might indicate or relate to a SARS -CoV-2 infection/ COVID-19-disease (general feeling of sickness, fever/temperature, newly emerging coughing, bad cold, disturbed sense of smell and/or taste)
- who has been in direct contact with another person who has been tested positive for SARS -CoV-2 infection/ COVID-19-disease within the last 14 days.
- Or who is subject to any other obligation for separation. Pls. see the current rules regarding quarantine, these are binding.

## **5. Pre-existing/chronic conditions**

Any person with pre-existing conditions showing symptoms similar to those of a SARS -CoV-2 infection/COVID-19-disease have to give qualified proof – notably by medical certificate or “allergy pass” - that respective symptoms are harmless and not related to a SARS -CoV-2 infection/COVID-19-disease. In case of no symptoms handing in a qualified proof is not necessary.

## **6. Obligation to inform**

Employees, students, parents/parental authorities of minor students have to inform the University immediately if tested positive for SARS -CoV-2 infection / COVID-19-disease or having been in contact with a person tested positive for SARS -CoV-2 infection/COVID-19-disease lately or are subject to another obligation for separation.

## **7. Obligation to wear masks**

On Campus wearing a medical mask or a FFP2- mask or a similar respiratory protective mask according to the SARS-CoV-2 Occupational Health and Safety Regulations is obligatory. Exemptions thereof apply to: resident students inside their own rooms, staff at their single workplace/ inside their single office, in shared offices as long as the distance pf 1,5m can be guaranteed, the room capacity will be met and as long as the rooms can be aired regularly), as well as to musicians playing their instruments if protective movable walls are in use. Apart from that, the respective teacher will decide according to the specific class / studio situation in line with the university's studio, capacity and distance regulations. In the outdoor areas wearing a mask is not obligatory if the distance of at least 1,5 m can be kept. It is obligatory to carry a medical mask with you at all times also if the formerly mentioned exemptions apply. Furthermore, wearing a medical mask is generally recommended.

## **8. Hygiene rules**

Inside Campus buildings and in the Campus outside areas a distance of at least 1,5 m has to be maintained everywhere at all times – this also applies to changing rooms, hallways, offices and dance studios. Group building is forbidden. Every room in use has to be aired thoroughly and on a regular basis. If the obligatory distance cannot be maintained due to mandatory specific duties, a FFP2-mask has to be worn by preference, at least though a medical mask. The coughing and sneezing etiquette has to be followed by all at all times

9. The current working time regulations for the administration are applicable until further notice.

10. As to separate facilities e.g. Library, Secondary School, specific rules and procedures have to be followed; there either will be respective directives or special notifications posted on-site.

### General information:

The rules are based upon the Corona Protection Ordinance of the respective state (here: state of Saxony). The rules are always subject to changes due to the pandemic situation.
